## Practice permit suspended effective today – Dr. Vincenzo Visconti

Dr. Vincenzo Visconti's practice permit (license) is suspended indefinitely as of 12:43 pm today, April 20, 2018, due to his failure to abide by conditions placed on his practice by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA). Dr. Visconti cannot see patients or practice medicine in any respect pending the outcome of discipline currently in process.
